## COME JOIN THE FUN!

- (1) *The first step in joining Briones Archers is to attend a minimum of two club functions (Maintenance Day, Monday night shoot, or Bear Creek Open). Then fill out the following personal information. **DO NOT MAIL.***
- (2) *Plan to attend a scheduled Maintenance Day\* and bring this form with you.*
- (3) *The Maintenance Days conclude around lunch time, after which we will hold a meeting to introduce people wanting to join, and provide them an opportunity to meet other members. If you have completed the required two events, the members present that day can formally vote you in as a provisional member. Submit this form with your \$100 application fee which covers immediate family.\*\**
- (4) *After you have been accepted for provisional membership, you will receive: a range key and a Briones Park parking pass.*
- (5) *In order to be eligible for regular membership, provisional members are required to participate in 4 Maintenance Days (16 hrs. minimum), and be sponsored by another regular member.*
